- Cassia Peeled, Scrapped from the Bark of a tree. Grinding the bark produces cinnamon. Used to make the Anointing oil Exodus 30:23-24 (A secret formula).
- Out of This begins a new thought in the NASB. "Out of ivory palaces stringed instruments have made You glad."
- Ivory To Denote Royalty 1 Kings 10:18; 2 Chronicles 9:15-17. Ivory, Tooth, white Gifts of nations 1 Kings 10:22
