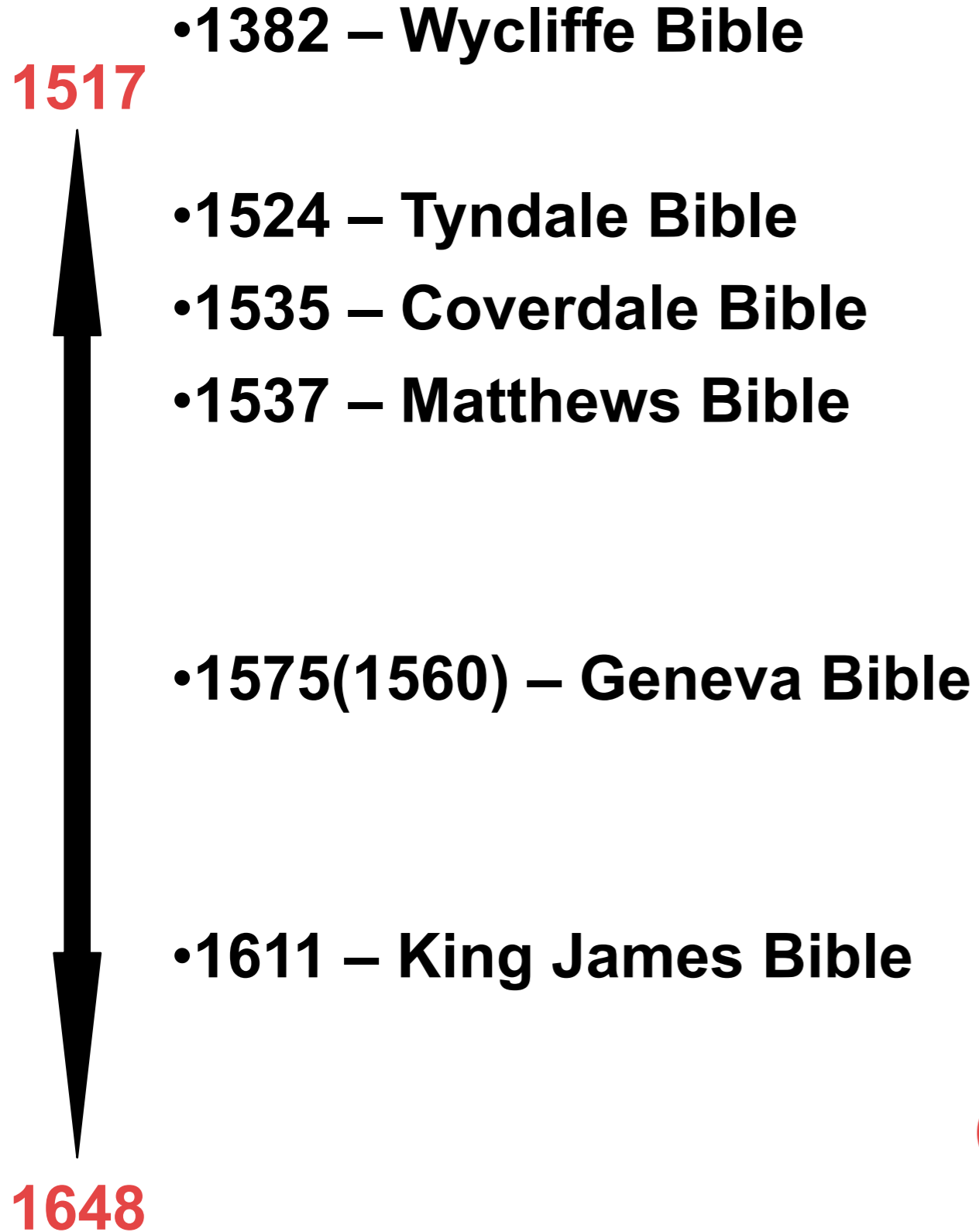

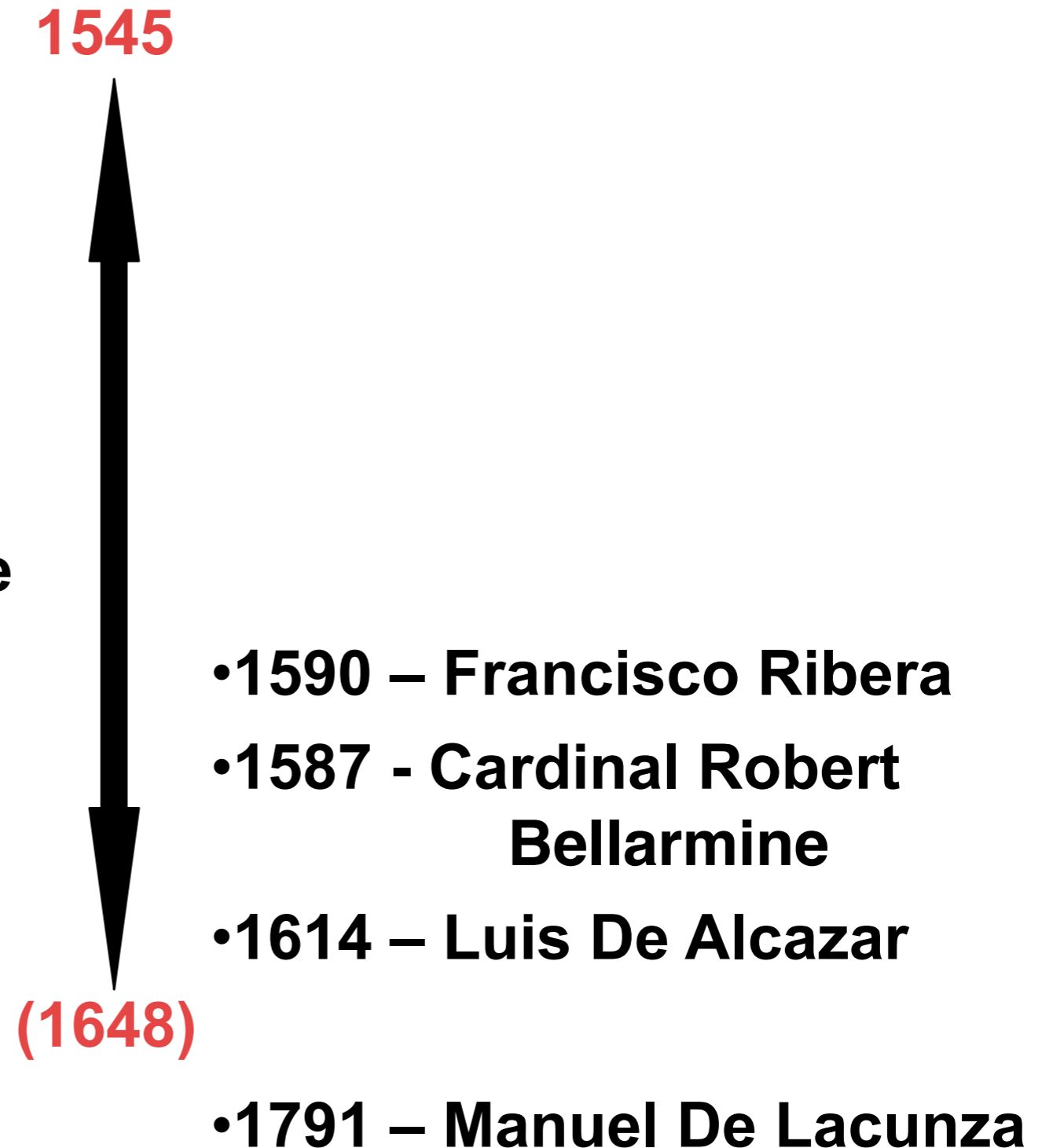

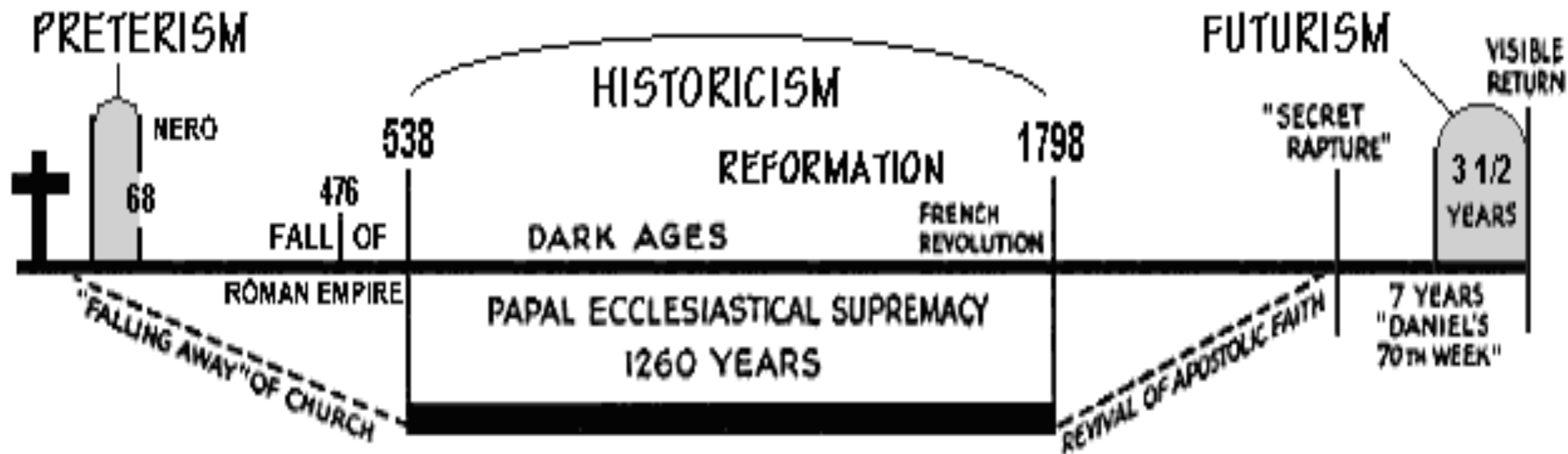

THE REIGN OF ANTICHRIST



ANTICHRIST IS MOVED EITHER FORWARD OR BACKWARD IN TIME

Ribera's Futurism Puts the Antichrist Into A Future Three and One-half Literal Years.

Alcazar's Preterism Identifies the Antichrist as Nero.

Both of Them Put Antichrist Outside the Middle Ages and the Reformation Period, Identified by Protestant Historicists as Antichrist's Reign of 1260 Prophetic Years.

1 Tim 6:5

KJV

Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: **from such withdraw thyself.**

NLT

These people always cause trouble. Their minds are corrupt, and they don't tell the truth. To them religion is just a way to get rich.

NASB

And constant friction between men of depraved mind and deprived of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means to gain.

NIV

And constant friction between men of corrupt mind, who have been robbed of the truth and who think that godliness is a means to financial gain.

Matt 5:22

KJV

But I say unto you, that whosoever is angry with his brother **without cause** shall be in danger of the judgement: ...

NLT

But I say, if you are angry with someone, you are subject to judgement...

NASB

But, I say unto you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be guilty before the court...

NIV

But I tell you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be subject to judgement...

1 John 4:3

KJV

And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus **is come in the flesh** is not of God: and this is the spirit of Antichrist, wherefore ye have heard that he shall come, and even now already is in the world.

NLT

If a prophet does not acknowledge Jesus, that person is not from God. Such a person has the spirit of Antichrist. You have heard that he is going to come into the world, and he is already here.

NASB

And every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God; this is the spirit of the Antichrist, of which you have heard that is coming, and now is already in the world.

NIV

But every Spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the Antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world.

Basileia

Thayer Definition:

1) royal power, kingship, dominion, rule

1a) not to be confused with an actual kingdom but rather the right or authority to rule over a kingdom

1b) of the royal power of Jesus as the triumphant Messiah

1c) of the royal power and dignity conferred on Christians in the Messiah's kingdom

2) a kingdom, the territory subject to the rule of a king

3) used in the N.T. to refer to the reign of the Messiah

From G935; **properly royalty**, that is, (abstractly) *rule*, or (concretely) a *realm* (literally or figuratively): - kingdom, + reign.
